
3. Protecting the Environment

What have the Liberal Democrats done for Bromley?

1. Blackfriars Service Reinstated

Our Beckenham councillors ran a long and persistent campaign and finally persuaded Southeastern to **reintroduce the Beckenham Junction to Blackfriars** service that had been withdrawn during the pandemic.



4. Fighting Digital Exclusion

New technology can make life easier and save money, but it can also exclude many. The Lib Dems have demanded there are safeguards and alternatives for everyone using public services including paying for parking.



2. Churchill Theatre Site Sale Revealed

Our Bromley Town Councillors highlighted the **Conservatives' plan to sell the Churchill Theatre site prior to demolition**. We're demanding guarantees that the site will have a theatre when it's rebuilt.



5. Improving our Parks

We have wonderful parks in Bromley but so many are showing signs of neglect. The Lib Dems have worked with Officers to prioritise repairs and maintenance in the worst affected.
