Thank goodness the Conservative Government has changed its mind about closing railway station ticket offices. Under this policy Hayes Station would have lost its ticket office and no doubt lost much needed staff.

At a recent Council meeting, it was Liberal Democrat Councillors who challenged the Southeastern representative to commit to maintaining staffing levels at stations where Ticket Offices were closed.

Tudor Griffiths welcomed the news saying "There are already concerns about anti-social behaviour and lack of ticket barriers that attract crime into Hayes. People want more station staff not less to help passengers and make the station more secure. What a relief that the Government has seen sense and scrapped its reckless plan to close Hayes ticket office".

Lib Dems Delivering for Bromley

1. Fighting Digital Exclusion

New technology can make life easier and save money, but it can also exclude many. The Lib Dems have demanded there are safeguards and alternatives for everyone using public services including paying for parking.



2. Public Toilets

Lack of public toilets in Bromley is a problem for people of all ages. The Lib Dems have demanded a strategy to fill the gaps in the borough plus better online information on where the toilets are. The Council has promised improvements.



3. Improving our Parks

We have wonderful parks in Bromley but so many are showing signs of neglect. The Lib Dems have worked with Council Officers to prioritise repairs and maintenance in the worst affected.



4. Churchill Theatre Site Sale Revealed

Our Bromley Town Councillors highlighted the **Conservatives’ plan to sell the Churchill Theatre site prior to demolition.** We’re demanding guarantees that the site will have a theatre when it’s rebuilt.
